


About the Museum

We are the only museum dedicated to Clyfford Still (1904–1980), a renegade artist who redefined American painting. Still helped create and launch Abstract Expressionism, an American movement that emerged after World War II. He left his work all to an unnamed American city when he died, and his widow, Patricia Still, selected Denver to become their home. Designed specifically to display Clyfford Still's art, the award-winning Clyfford Still Museum is home to nearly everything he created, approximately 3,125 pieces representing 93% of his life's work.

The Museum is a gathering place for our community and supports new artistic endeavors, inviting visitors to draw strength from the art and life of Clyfford Still. We are about more than just one man. We want you to feel welcome to see the art through the lens of your own experiences—there are no wrong answers. Our exhibitions are designed to stimulate curiosity, arouse emotions, and open your mind to engage with multiple perspectives.





About the Still's Rental Program

The Museum's world-class architecture features a dense cantilevered structure made of textured cast-in-place concrete and is an iconic backdrop for exquisite events. All rentals include:




